## Directions

The Lodge is about 45 miles from both the San Francisco and Oakland Airports:

### From San Francisco & South Bay Counties

1. Travel west on Sir Francis Drake Boulevard for about 45 minutes until the road ends at a stop sign for Highway One.
2. Turn right and go two miles to a second Sir Francis Drake Boulevard.
3. Turn left and travel about 10 minutes to Inverness. The Resort will be located on the right.

### From Oakland & East Bay Counties

1. Take Highway 580 Westbound across the Richmond/San Rafael Bridge
2. Exit at Sir Francis Drake Boulevard and continue West
3. Follow directions as outlined above
